

**NOTICE INVITING TENDER**

- 1 Sealed item rate tenders are invited for the works mentioned below from the contractors/ Firms registered in appropriate class of C.P.W.D., Railways, MES, Post & Telegraph Department, State PWD's, Semi Government organizations and/or from those, who have successfully carried out similar works for CSIR or its laboratories/Institutes or Government Organizations having required T & P and from Contractors/ firms working with Government Organizations / public sector undertakings. The Tender document will be issued only to those contractors, who have satisfactorily executed similar works of value:

- (a) Three similar works, each 40 % of estimated cost or
- (b) Two similar works each of value 50% of estimated cost or
- (c) One similar work of 80% estimated cost

And show proof of their Registration, Experience, Sales Tax Certificate and Capability to the full satisfaction of the officer issuing the tenders:

- (2) All intending tenderers may note that the work is of urgent nature and it is to be completed within specified days and those who are capable of carrying out the work in time need only apply for work.
- (3) The last date for sale of tenders to the eligible contractors shall be **11-02-2010**. The cost of each set of Tender Documents (non-refundable) as mentioned above shall be payable by cash to the cashier, NEIST, Jorhat
- (4) While submitting tender bids, tenderers shall submit Earnest Money Deposit in a sealed envelop of small size marked as "A: EARNEST MONEY" and the tender documents in the second sealed envelop marked as "B: TENDER" and both these envelops shall be put and submitted in a third sealed cover. The Name of Work, Estimated Cost and Dates of Opening, Name of the contractor with address etc. shall be clearly indicated on all the three envelops properly by the contractors. During opening, if EARNEST MONEY is not found in the proper and prescribe form the tender shall be summarily rejected.
- (5) Duly filled and signed tenders will be received upto 3:00 p.m on **15-02-2010** in the Office of The Controller of Administration, NEIST, Jorhat and will be opened on the same day at 3:30 pm in the presence of the intending contractors or their authorized representatives. The earnest money as mentioned above as demand draft/ Banker's Cheque/ Pay Order/ Deposit at call receipt, issued by any recognized Bank only, in favour of DIRECTOR, North-East Institute of Science & Technology, Jorhat only.
- (6) If any of these days happens to be Holiday, the action will be carried forwarded to the next working day
- (7) Tenders, in which any of the prescribe conditions is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer, shall be summarily rejected.
- (8) Tender submitted shall remain valid for 90 days from the date of opening
- (9) The Employer does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole any part of tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rates quoted.
